Ordinance No. 2744

The following entitled ordinance was introduced at a Regular Meeting held Tuesday, May 17, 2016; it was duly published; a copy was posted on the bulletin board in City Hall; copies were made available to the general public and having complied with the law, this ordinance was not read in full and the City Council can now proceed with the public hearing and final passage:

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 2731 ADOPTED BY THE CITY OF GARFIELD ON MARCH 8, 2016 CONCERNING THE SALARY, WAGES AND COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF GARFIELD, BERGEN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY AND TO REINSTATE PRIOR ORDINANCE NO. 2661 ADOPTED JULY 23, 2013, SUBJECT TO RECOGNITION OF THE FULL IMPLEMENTATION OF EMPLOYEE CONTRIBUTIONS PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 39, 42, AND 44 OF p.l.2011 CHAPTER 78

CITIZENS AND TAXPAYERS

Mr. Anthony Molinari, 53 Emmanuel Street, complained that his neighbor installed a fence too close to his property line on property he owns at Palisade Avenue and Monroe Street. He complained that Superintendent of Public Works Sam Garofalo took his garbage cans and told him that he cannot store his garbage cans in the front of the house.
