1. The regular meeting of Wednesday, April 27, 2022 was called to order at 7: PM by President, Ruth Springer.

3. President, Ruth Springer read the following statement:

Due to the current COVID-19 quarantine, notice of this meeting was posted electronically on Facebook, the city webpage, and the Garfield Free Public Library webpage.

4. It was moved by Mayor Richard Rigoglioso and seconded by Suny Mellawa and unanimously carried to accept the Minutes from March, 2022.

Director's Report:

- Director attended:
 - Both the Director's and the Trustee's New Jersey State Library Check-In for the month of March.
- Monday April 4th, the Director had a meeting with the Mayor to discuss the financial issues of the library.
- The Director is working on the Updated reports for the New Jersey Construction Bond Act and the ARPA Grants since there have been sewer line issues that are postponing the completion of the downstairs NJ Construction Bond Act project and delayed shipping of the items for ARPA project.
- The new coin vending machine for the copier has been successfully installed and operating.
- Saturday March 26th, April 2, 9 and 23rd the Polish School will use the Library building for 3 High School Polish classes because the Middle School was closed to them due to their issues. The Director made it clear that the school and parents knowing there is ongoing construction in the Community room and no public restrooms are available consented to using the library.
- The City Manager did get back to me that the situation stays as is even though I was informed by Tom Duch that the money was coming from the City not the library for Pam Piro's early retirement offer.
- It is my impression that the library will not be getting money above the 1/3 mil and therefore I have taken action to eliminate any spending for the rest of the year. No new books, ink cartridges, soap, toilet paper etc. Services to the community will be reduced: the number of available Hot Spots is reduced and Hoopla will be canceled.
- The sewer line will not be repaired because the city doesn't have any money to pay for any costs outside the original scope of the Grant. The library has paid for

two of the work order changes because the pipes were collapsing as they attempted to connect the new plumbing.
